Comment: The population of Glover Park overall was up by 6.7% over the year 2000, but for selected groups—such as the late teens, the 50-54 group, and the 75+ groups, the rate is significantly down, sometimes by almost one-third. At the same time that the population 75+ declined, there was almost a doubling in the population 65-69.

However, these figures also mask the inexorable decline of population in Glover Park since 2000, starting already in the 30-34 year-old age group, and continuing non-stop into older ages. The following shows number of people in a particular 5-year age group for 2010 compared to the same group of people 10 earlier in 2000.
